Pastor Jeff's Jottings

Six down, fourteen to go!! I just finished my sixth class in my Course of Study. Thank you to each of you for your support and your patience with me when I get in crunch time writing my papers.

The class that I just finished up is by far the most insightful and valuable class I have taken yet. So important that I decided I am going to do a sermon series on one of the texts that was required for the course. The name of the class was Spiritual Formation and Discipleship. Christ called us to "go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28:19) The focus of this class was how we, individually and as the church, can best accomplish this calling.

The text I will be using is called *Soul Feast* by Marjorie Thompson. The book's subtitle is *An Invitation to the Christian Spiritual Life*. Anyone can say that they believe in Christ and call themselves Christian. But how do you prove it by the way you live your daily life? It's not the conversion we are most interested in, it's the transformation of lives.

Beginning on August 25 and continuing for nine weeks, I will guide you in developing your own "Rule of Life." We will look at topics such as spiritual reading, prayer, worship, sabbath, fasting, self-examination, spiritual direction, and hospitality. How do we use these disciplines to become true disciples of Jesus Christ? Can we live them out in our everyday lives? How will they help lead us to our true salvation?

Also, small group studies that took a summer break will resume on September 8 and 9. Even if you were not a part of the original study of Ephesians, you are welcome to join either one of these classes. The Sunday group meets at 6:00pm and the Monday group at 7:00pm. Please make a note of these dates and times.

I am also considering offering another membership class this fall. If you are interested in learning more about the church and possibly becoming a member, please sign up or contact me for more information.
